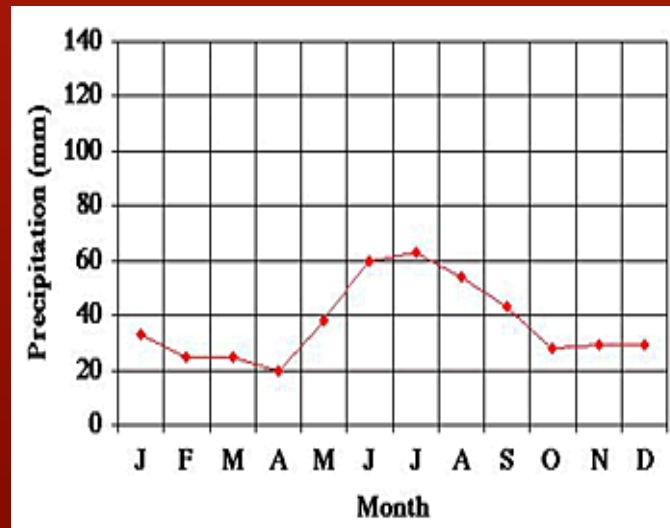
# The Locations of the Deciduous Forest

- 10 to 14 pounds
- Hollow bones
- Predator/Scavenger

- hunted



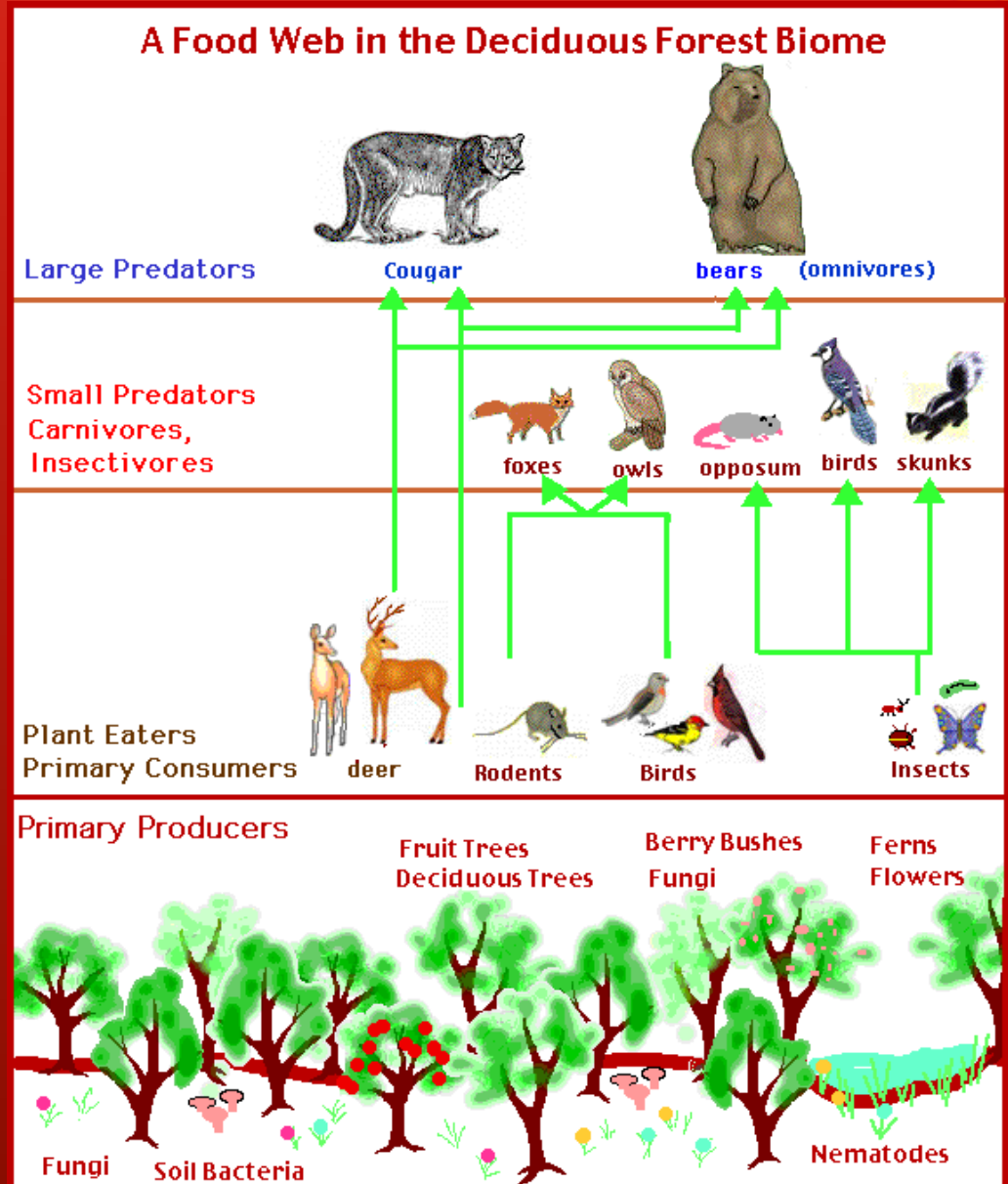
## Chipmunk
