
Penny-Dime-Dollar Exchange



Materials 1 dollar, 20 dimes, 20 pennies

1 Place-Value Mat with Money per player

(Math Masters, page TA30)

2 dot dice

1 sheet of paper labeled "Bank"

Skill Making place-value exchanges

Object of the Game To exchange for a dollar

Directions

1) Place all of the money in the bank.

2 Players take turns. When it is your turn:

• Roll the dice.

Take that number of cents from the bank.
 Place the coins on the mat.

• If you have 10 or more pennies in the Pennies column, exchange 10 pennies for 1 dime.

 If you have 10 or more dimes in the Dimes column, exchange 10 dimes for 1 dollar.

3 The winner is the first player to make the exchange

for a dollar.
