We will begin Show and Tell Monday, January, 31. Your child may bring **ONE** item to school for show and tell. The chosen item must **easily fit** into your child's backpack. Please encourage your child to decide what to bring, following these guidelines. Avoid weapons and anything that may offend or frighten another child, and please avoid bringing valuable or highly treasured items.

Our goals for show and tell are to help the children feel comfortable presenting in front of a group and to continue to develop verbal skills. Your child may tell about their object: where they keep it, who gave it to them, what they do with it, and so on. The audience will have an opportunity to ask questions.

We hope this will be a fun time for your child. There will be a special box for show and tell "treasures". Show and tell items will be **secret** until show and tell time and will go back home the same day.

Show and tell is every week. Please help your child remember to bring something on their assigned day. (We do not make up missed show and tell days. eg: if we have a holiday on Monday, those children will not have show and tell until the next Monday.)

It doesn't hurt to keep a back up item in the car, just in case! Some children become upset if they forget. In a pinch, we will also accept an emailed photo, which we can print so your child can share! We will help with reminders the first few weeks.
