Field Trip

On Thursday, November 10, we will travel to Ferry Farm. We are beginning to learn about different kinds of homes and the differences and similarities between now and long ago. At Ferry Farm, we will learn from an archeologist some of the ways that we know about the past. We will actually work in an archeological dig site.

Reading

This week, the children will begin to bring home reading books. Each child will occasionally have a blue folder which will have a book enclosed that has already been read at school. Please listen to your child read the book to you and then place it back in the folder and return it to school so that your child may keep it in his/her book box.
